Hello and Welcome back to a New School Year!

Over the next few weeks I am looking forward to getting to know you all and helping your children settle back into school routines. In Beech Class I share my responsibilities with Mrs Moosa, Mrs Ilyas who are our fantastic Teaching Assistants. We have got an exciting and busy term planned for the children.

Reading will be a key focus this term as reading opens up opportunities and develops your child's understanding of stories, recognising sound and writing sentences that make sense.

In maths our focus is on our numbers, counting forwards and backwards to 30 leading to 100, writing these correctly and also learning our number words. We will have a strong emphasis on place value, which involves learning about the value of each number.

In English we will be learning to read and write basic sentences using phonics knowledge and basic punctuation.

Finally, please could I ask that you send your child's reading book bag in every day and a named water bottle. If you have any questions or concerns please don't hesitate to contact me by dropping me a message on Dojo or speak to me at the end of the day.
