Vision / Intent for Physical Education: At Daisyfield Primary School we believe that Physical Education, Physical Activity and School Sport (PESSPA) are a fundamental part of every school day. We aim to provide high quality experiences to promote an active lifestyle for the children which extends beyond formal PE lessons. By providing a broad and balanced curriculum, daily physical activity and extra curricular opportunities we aim to inspire lifelong healthy lifestyles. PESSPA offers a unique opportunity for the development of the "whole child", physically, mentally and socially.

What's working well: The new PE scheme allows for a broad, balanced and progressive curriculum from EYFS-Y6. Staff are increasingly confident in teaching PE and the FMS and basic skills of our pupils has improved.

Next steps: Encourage staff to implement physical activity at different points during the school day. Allow deeper learning of pupils by manipulating tasks to encourage the development of thinking skills in PE. Continue to promote extra curricular clubs.

Impact of CPD: Through weekly lessons with our specialist PE teacher, staff are more confident in teaching a wider range of areas of PE. By working with ES staff see the lesson plans with their own class.

How ALL children are catered for: SOW provides opportunities for differentiation. Staff know how to adapt activities through the STEP principles. SEN pupils are supported in PE lessons. What PE looks like from Reception— year 6: We focus on FMS throughout school to promote access to NCPE starting in EYFS. Use of progressive curriculum through all Key Stages.

What children would say about PE:

They like being able to do PE with their friends. They like learning new activities. They prefer outdoor PE lessons.

How the scheme has been adapted to suit our children: The skills covered build year on year. We have a big emphasis on FMS to ensure a solid foundation for ALL pupils.
